ATHLETIC COACHES*

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

The Athletic Coach shall, under the direction of the Principal, Assistant Principal and the immediate supervision of the Athletic Director, trains, directs, and supervises a competitive athletic team.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. Selects team members.
- b. Schedules practices.
- c. Ensures attendance and participation at scheduled competitive events.
- d. Maintains compliance with CIF, League and District rules and regulations.
- e. Schedules medical examinations for team members, establishes medical and safety precautions and handles athletic injuries.
- f. Ensures team members are insured.
- g. Ensures team members maintain eligibility.
- h. Supervises the play of the team.

OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- a. Arranges for transportation to and from athletic events.
- b. Monitors student behavior so that team members represent the District in an appropriate manner.
- c. Oversees the use and maintenance of equipment.
- d. Upgrades coaching skills as necessary.
- e. Assists junior high and elementary school staffs and volunteer programs to establish training, stimulates interest and teaches fundamentals of the sport.
- f. Develops physical training activities and game style for all teams of the same sport.

EXTRA DUTY PAY

The Athletic Coach's pay shall be based on the extra duty rate of pay stated in current certificated contract.

PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Must be able to bend, stoop, reach, lift and stand for prolonged periods; see to read, use hands and fingers to perform tasks; speak clearly and hear well enough to communicate effectively. Adequate flexibility to demonstrate pivoting and rotation activities associated with sport including lateral motion of both upper and lower extremities.

*Non-certificated coaches must successfully complete a required course with Oxnard Union High School District Adult Education pursuant to provisions of the Education Code.
