BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF POSITION:

The Science Coach will serve for one year as a member of the Educational Services Division under the direct supervision of the Principal.

MAJOR DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

OUHSD Science students and teachers will directly benefit from the Science Coach services including:

- a. Using strategies to better engage EL and SPED students and improve academic literacy. E
- b. Designing and coordinating the presentation of standards-based, best practices including differentiated instruction, academic literacy, SDAIE, SPED inclusion, and other enrichment at Job-Alikes. E
- c. Identifying and sharing remedial curriculum to use as a part of targeted tutorials for students who have fallen behind. E
- d. Providing assistance to the schools and the district to support effective use of collaboration time among science teachers based on student data. E
- e. Serving on a committee which will collate linguistic structures germane to science content. E
- f. Providing support to ELA and math teachers in implementing Common Core standards. E.

As a part of their duties, each coach will be asked to complete a portfolio that documents the following activities:

- a. Attendance at monthly coordination meetings with the District Learning Design Coach. E
- b. Participation in Common Core training. E
- c. Design standards-based best practice curriculum. E
- d. Workshop materials and classroom lessons from presentations offered at OUHSD and additional professional development days. E
- e. Collaborative (PLC) meeting agendas showing how they have shared academic literacy practices. E
