

REVISED PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice of Availability of a Draft Environmental Impact Report (Public Meeting Time Change)

Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21091 and California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15105, notice is hereby given that a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the proposed Camarillo Academy High School + Performing Arts Center (CAHS + PAC) project (proposed project) is available for public review during the public comment period (May 6–June 19, 2013). The Oxnard Union High School District (OUHSD) has prepared the DEIR to analyze the environmental impacts associated with implementation of the proposed project, to discuss alternatives, and to propose mitigation measures for identified potentially significant impacts that will minimize, offset, or otherwise reduce or avoid those environmental impacts. The project site is located within the unincorporated area of Ventura County, immediately adjacent to the City of Camarillo. The project site abuts Las Posas Road near the Camarillo Public Library. The proposed project consists of a new high school and a performing arts center with associated facilities, including an administration building, classrooms, a laboratory, media centers, a food service and multipurpose dining building, an exercise room, maintenance and operations shed, central plant yard for mechanical equipment, one multipurpose recreational field, parking lots for automobiles and buses, and internal roadways. Improvements adjacent to the school site include roadway extensions, driveway modifications, new traffic signals, and connections to utilities.

The DEIR examines the potential impacts generated by the proposed project in relation to the following Environmental Analysis Checklist categories: Aesthetics, Agricultural Resources, Air Quality, Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils, Greenhouse Gas Emissions, Hazards and Hazardous Materials, Hydrology and Water Quality, Land Use and Planning, Noise, Population and Housing, Public Services, Recreation, Transportation/Traffic, and Utilities and Service Systems. The project site is not listed as a hazardous waste site under Government Code Section 65962.5. The proposed project would result in significant unavoidable adverse impacts related to loss of agricultural resources and construction air quality.

The purpose of this notice is to inform local residents, institutions, agencies, and other interested parties about the availability of the DEIR during the public comment period (May 6–June 19, 2013). **Written comments on the DEIR must be submitted no later than June 19, 2013, to the address below. An Open House Public Information Meeting will be held on June 1, 2013, from 1:30 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Center for Spiritual Living, 340 Mobil Avenue, Camarillo, California.**
