

CLOSED CAMPUS

In order to protect students in a supervised, safe, and orderly environment, the Oxnard Union High School District shall adopt a closed campus policy for each of the high schools. Parents expect schools to be a safe learning environment for their children whereby schools have the responsibility to account for each and every student every minute on campus and with the heightened concerns of school safety, a closed campus is essential to protect our students.

Once students arrive at school, they must remain on campus until the end of the school day unless they have brought written authorization from their parents/guardians and received permission from school authorities to leave for a specific purpose. The specific written authorization from their parents/guardians shall be only for the specific date and does not allow a student to leave campus on a regular basis. Students must remain on campus during lunch time and shall not leave campus just for the purpose of lunch. Students who leave campus without such authorization shall be classified as truant and subject to disciplinary actions which are outlined in the student handbook.
