The Board reconvened at 5:35 p.m. President Davis reported out that during Closed session no action was taken. President Davis noted Trustees didn't conclude their discussion of the Closed Session; therefore, they will reconvene to Closed Session once the Open Session items have been concluded.

On May 15th the District had a public meeting to accept bids on the following properties:

220 South K Street; 309-315 South K Street; 1101 West 2nd Street; 15 Stearman Street; 280 Skyway Drive Site; 330 Skyway Drive; Bell Ranch; 527 Hueneme Road; 3400 W Gonzales Road. Bids were accepted for Bell Ranch and 1101 West 2nd Street. An Extension of Negotiations will be submitted for the 280 and 330 Skyway Drive properties.

The remaining five properties identified as:

527 Hueneme Road 3400 W Gonzales Road 15 Stearman Street 220 South K Street 309-315 South K Street

These five properties will be put up for sale through the conventional real estate sales process.

President Davis opened the public hearing at 5:37 p.m. Mr. Weinstein informed Trustees and the public that the District still has efforts pending for the sale of the properties listed above, but if they are not successful then the District will seek a waiver from the State Board of Education to allow the District to advertise and sell the listed properties through negotiated sale rather than public auction, subject to Board approval at an open and noticed meeting. Before authorizing a waiver request, the Board is required to hold a public hearing for comment which was advertised in the Ventura County Star. Mr. Weinstein informed Trustees that the District has not received any written requests as to the proposed waiver request. No oral comments received; therefore, President Davis closed the public hearing at 5:40 p.m.

13. STAFF REPORTS District-Wide Student Restrooms

The report presented reviewed current restroom facilities and procedures at OUHSD school sites as well as changes being made in order to maintain compliance with California Department of Education regulations.

Trustees inquired about restroom availability at the larger sites during nutrition and lunch breaks. Dr. DeLeon added the restroom concern has to do with staffing issues. Trustees were informed that some restrooms have been closed due to vandalism resulting from lack of campus supervisors available to supervise restrooms. Trustee Edmonds asked if the District is staffed appropriately to the size of the schools or is the District under the CASBO formula based on square footage. Mr. Brown affirmed the District is understaffed per the formula. Trustees were informed that six restrooms need to be added to suffice the formula. Trustees inquired if all restrooms are ever opened at any of the sites. Mr. Brown replied it is not typical for all to be open. Trustees expressed their concern about restrooms being used for storage. Principals have been asked to supply a schedule to the Executive Cabinet regarding restroom supervision or any deviation to the schedules provided. Mr. Weinstein proposed that sites be required to get approval of restroom closures, other than for repair or cleaning due to vandalism, from an Assistant Superintendent, Mr. Weinstein or Dr. McCoy, so they can determine if the closure is appropriate. Trustees were informed once additional campus supervisors are hired then a greater number of restrooms should be available for students to be aligned to the CASBO formula, beginning next school year. Trustees asked to have clear signage available for students directing them to the available restroom when restrooms have been closed. Trustees were informed that the smaller sites have not had any trouble with restroom availability.

Architecture for Education plans and designs environments that inspire every student to excel, supporting a lifelong love of learning that is encouraged by multiple educational pathways. Trustees were updated on the Measure A timeline and progress.

Trustees asked if school lobbies will be ADA compliant and it was affirmed, they would be. Trustees were informed that signage to the athletic areas, at the new school site, will be available and in more than one language. Trustees recommended that a plaque be used to honor someone at a particular site, not signage. Trustees were informed that HVAC upgrades will begin in 2020 due to the necessary steps that need to be done first. Trustees expressed their concerns about the quantity of restrooms built for Oxnard HS #8 and availability of unisex restrooms. Trustees thanked A4E for their presentation.
