Annual Notification of Pesticide Use at School Sites through Parent Square and Exemption Request

Dear Parent or Guardian.

The Healthy Schools Act requires that all schools provide parents or quardians of students with annual written notification of expected pesticide use on school sites. This notification will identify the active ingredient or ingredients in each pesticide product and will include the Internet address (https://www.cdpr.ca.gov/) for further information on pesticides and their alternatives. The Oxnard Union High School District (OUHSD) utilizes an Integrated Pest Management Program (IPM) and Information on this program can be found at our webpage (https://www.oxnardunion.org/)

OUHSD uses the computer-based parent or quardian notification program called Parent Square for all site notifications regarding pesticide applications at a particular school site. These notifications will be sent through the Parent Square program at least 72 hours before pesticides are applied. Additionally, signage at the site of application will be used to further identified the areas where treatment has occurred. This letter is to inform you that you will receive notifications of pesticide applications through Parent Square as a parent or guardian of a student at an OUHSD school site, and no further action is required.
